## **Customized Logo**

The customized logo files you will receive are:



- Full colour, black, grey and white versions of your logo
- RGB files of each logo version to use for electronic purposes
  Including social media versions
- CMYK files of each logo version to use for printing purposes

The file types you'll receive include:

- Adobe Illustrator, **.ai file**, this is the original graphic design file with all your logos in it, you will need the Adobe Illustrator program to open it.
- .eps files, this file is a vector file that can be resized without losing quality, you would use this file if you're creating any type of branded promotional materials, e.g., pens, notepads, frisbees.
- .png files, this file is used for most online uses because it supports transparent backgrounds, you would use this file for things like letterhead, social media and programs like Canva.

#### **E-letterhead**

The FCSSAA will also provide an e-letterhead Word document with your customized logo.

## **Additional Branded Documents**

If you so choose, you can also have the FCSSAA rebrand up to five of your existing Word documents with your customized logo and the colours of the branding/identity guide.
